Dr Marc and Michal Arkovitz moved to New Rochelle nearly 3 years ago from Jerusalem. Marc is a pediatric surgeon at Westchester Medical Center and an associate professor of surgery and pediatrics at New York Medical College. He made aliyah to Israel in 2009 and met Michal shortly after. Michal is a native Israeli having grown up on Moshav Bnei Zion in the center of Israel. Prior to moving to New York, Michal worked as a prosecutor in the office of the state attorney in the Israeli ministry of justice. They have Five children and two of them are students of Stein Yeshiva.

When the family moved from Yerushalaim to Westchester three years ago, one of their top priorities was finding quality Jewish education for their children. They believe they have found that quality education at the Stein

Yeshiva in Yonkers. The Arkovitz' youngest son Yehuda and youngest daughter Aviya are Learning at Stein, Yehuda is in kindergarten and Aviya in the day care.

For Ronald and Stephanie Sabban, their greatest joy is to be the proud parents of their two children, Gila and Zoey. When Zoe turned two, it was unclear as to where the Sabbans would send her for preschool. Based on rave reviews from close friends, they decided to look at Stein. Soon after Zoe started Stein Yeshiva, they felt confident that they had made a great choice. In her 2s classroom, Zoe was learning how to count in 3 languages: English, Hebrew and French. The Sabbans were astounded by the level of enrichment. They felt that the learning environment had so much to offer children who were ready, while being laid back and welcoming for all. Zoe went home singing every day.

"This is now our child's third year at Stein," Stephanie writes, "and I can attest to the warmth and caring in the school. Zoe LOVES going to school every day. She loves her teachers and I know that each of her teachers cares deeply about her. When Zoe had to miss a week of school, an administrator took the time to do a zoom project with her one-on-one."

Shmuel Frydman was born to holocaust survivor parents in Israel. They moved to the Lower East Side when he was a just a month old. Shmuel attended Mesivta Tiferes Yerushalayim and was a Talmid of Rabbi Dovid Feinstein TZ"l. Chana Beila grew up in Monsey. After the Frydmans married, they lived on the Lower East Side for the next 19 years where they enjoyed the rich Jewish environment.

Thirteen years ago, the Frydmans moved to Rockland County. They daven in Congregation Ohaiv Shalom in New Hempstead. Shmuel is very involved in the shul and is always willing to lend a hand when needed. When he is not occupied with his chesed work, Shmuel is a distributor for seforim and Judaica vendors. Chana Beila is an avid

supporter of and volunteer for Renewal, which is very important to her as she is a kidney donor. She has also been a doula for the past 20 years.

The Frydmans have 6 children and 4 grandchildren, *kh*. Their youngest son, Shuli, is currently a talmid in the Learning Pavilion at Stein Yeshiva where he is thriving in the warm and loving environment and is happy to go to school every day.
