CAMP SHEMESH

Agreement:

Camp Shemesh is Stein Yeshiva of Lincoln Park's summer program for early childhood children. Please read the following.

Deposit & Fees: A non-refundable deposit of \$250 is due at the time of registration along with two checks dated for March 15, 2023 and May 15, 2023 for the balance of the tuition (the deposit is credited towards tuition). Please note that registration is not complete without the tuition payment checks. If families register after May 1st, 2023, payment of the entire tuition is due at that time. Children may not attend Camp Shemesh unless the tuition is paid in full. The tuition fee will be based on the number of weeks your child/ren will be attending. **Please make all checks payable to Stein Yeshiva.**

Transportation: Bus transportation is available from central Riverdale. Bus reservations are made on a first come- first serve basis and a check of \$700 dated for immediate deposit should be sent at the time of registration. Checks should be made payable to Stein Yeshiva. Spots on the bus cannot be held without payment. Bus fees are not refundable after April 30th. Any transportation agreements made with individuals to transport children to and from the Camp Shemesh Program are private arrangements not under the jurisdiction of Stein Yeshiva and Stein Yeshiva bears no responsibility for them.

Cancellation: Tuition fees are refundable, except for the deposit, until May 31, 2023. Cancellations from June 1 until June 12, 2023 are subject to a 50% refund rate. We regret that from June 13, 2022 on, we are unable to offer refunds for early withdrawals, absences, or closures; nor may weeks be switched if a child was absent during a scheduled week. Bus fees are not refundable after April 30th.

Camp Shemesh reserves the unrestricted right at any time to **terminate** a child's enrollment consistent with the needs of the program. Tuition will be pro-rated up until that date, excluding the deposit which non-refundable.

Medical Forms: Up-to-date medical forms need to be on file in the camp office before camp starts. Forms can be emailed to the camp. All relevant medical and social/emotional health information should be communicated to the Camp Director. **Parents agree not send any campers to camp if they are sick or have a fever of 100° or above, and will promptly notify a the Camp Director of any illnesses.**

Miscellaneous: In order for Camp Shemesh to share our campers' days with their families and to promote our program, we depend on your support to use images of our campers. Photographs are taken throughout the summer and may be used for publicity purposes.

Suntan lotion will be applied to children as needed.

Camp activities: Parents understand that their children will go swimming and/or engage in water play where age appropriate.

Food: Lunch will be provided under the auspices of Jerusalem Pizza and Mauzone. Snacks should be brought from home, should be kosher, and in labeled lunch bags. Please remember that **Camp Shemesh/Stein Yeshiva is a nut and seed aware facility and any food sent into the yeshiva should be nut/seed free.**

COVID-19 Notice and Disclosures: While the COVID-19 vaccine has been widely distributed, nevertheless, it must be noted that an inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any place where people are present. Consistent with NYS guidance and Westchester County, Camp Shemesh/Stein Yeshiva continues to implement policies and practices to help promote a safer environment. Circumstances are continually evolving and government policies changing, therefore, it is understood, that Camp Shemesh/Stein Yeshiva will continue to adapt its health policies to be in compliance with NYS regulations and to follow best practices. Families are expected to comply with those policies.

In the unfortunate event of a dispute, families agree that the first recourse for both parties should be a Beis Din of Stein Yeshiva's choice.
